

- Dr. Pankaj Thote read the minutes of 10<sup>th</sup> meeting & presented its action taken report. It was unanimously approved by all the members.
- 2. Dean Academics Dr. Pankaj Thote informed all the members that Institute's Academic calendar was well adhered by all the departments for the session 2019-20 (EVEN), the continuous academic monitoring was carried out throughout the session and the syllabus was nearer to completion by all the departments. The Institute followed continuous assessment in practical hours. Contents beyond syllabus were also executed followed by workshops, seminars, skill enhancement

programmes for advance learning of the students. Special remedial classes were also taken for poor performing students. Mr. Mandar Kulkarni thanked Dean Academics for all the academic efforts for the student's development and requested the IQAC to also cater the stress related need of the students from time to time.

He also highlighted that no major comment was given by the reviewing officer before its acceptance.
